Diljit Dosanjh-Tapsee Pannu's Soorma to be screened at Bollywood Film Festival Norway

After enthraling the audiences in India, Shaad Ali's Soorma is gearing up for the Bollywood Film Festival Norway. As per reports, Soorma became an official selection at the 16th Annual Bollywood Festival Norway 2018, which starts on September 7, and the film will be screened on September 8. Soorma is a 2018 Indian sports drama film based on the life of hockey player Sandeep Singh and the film stars Diljit Dosanjh, Tapsee Pannu and Angad Bedi.

Talking about the film, Angad Bedi, who is portraying the role of Sandeep Singh's brother in the film said, "This journey is about two brothers. Yes, it's a biopic about Sandeep Singh as he was the one who was shot in his spine but at the same time, it's about the sacrifices of his brother. It's Bikramjeet Singh's sacrifice that got Sandeep back on feet. There was a time when Sandeep was told that he couldn't play Hockey anymore but it was his brother who helped him go back on the field. Bikram made him work 10 times harder and help him improvise. The film is not about Hockey. People have seen Chak De! It's about two brothers and it's how Bikram helped Sandeep come back to playing Hockey."





To inspire children with Sandeep Singh's story, a special screening of the film was also held for few schools across India and Paraplegic Rehabilitation Center in Pune for the soldiers. For all those who don't know, Sandeep has been hailed as one of the world's most dangerous drag-flickers of all time with drag speeds of over 145 km/hr, which led to his nickname, 'Flicker Singh'.
